Propositions:

The competition is held according to the rules of PSS, WA and this competition.

Categories are closed, except category A (absolute).

In the qualifications, the ranking is determined by category and the ranking for the A and B finals.

For the A category, medals can only be won from the A final races.

For other categories, medals are won in qualifications.

The deadline for checking out of the final races is 20 minutes per qualified race.

The competition is held according to the principle of qualifications and finals. The best 3 groups in each discipline swim the entire competition, and then the slower groups perform.

In the disciplines of 800 and 1500 free, 400 medley and 200 fly, only the direct A final is swum according to the registered time. Other registered competitors swim in the qualifications, in slower groups.

The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of competitors in the disciplines 800 and 1500 free to a maximum of two groups in the qualifications.

Each competitor has the right to swim in an unlimited number of disciplines.

Each club can enter a maximum of two relays. Relays can only be composed of age group D.

Standings for categories B, C and D is determined in the qualifications.

The winner of the Memorial in a category is the swimmer who earns the most WA (FINA)

points from 4 disciplines, two on Saturday and two on Sunday exclusively from the A or B final races. Standings in the final and the result from the final takes precedence over the result from the qualifiers, regardless of the number of WA points. If there are not enough competitors of a certain category in the final races, the results from the qualifications are counted.

Rewards:

The first three competitors in each discipline and category will be awarded medals.

The winner of the Memorial for the category receives a valuable merchandise prize in swimming equipment

Other provisions:

By registering their competitors for this competition, the clubs confirm that their swimmers have been medically examined and, as such, fit to compete. The competition is held according to the provisions of the Law on Sports of the RS, the PSS Competition Rules and other normative acts of the PSS. International swimming rules and other rules of WA (FINA) apply to all matters that are not regulated by the extract from the propositions of this competition, the Competition Regulations and the Regulations on the organization of the competition and participation in the competition.

All costs are borne by the participants of the competition

The organizer is not responsible for the personal belongings of the competition participants
